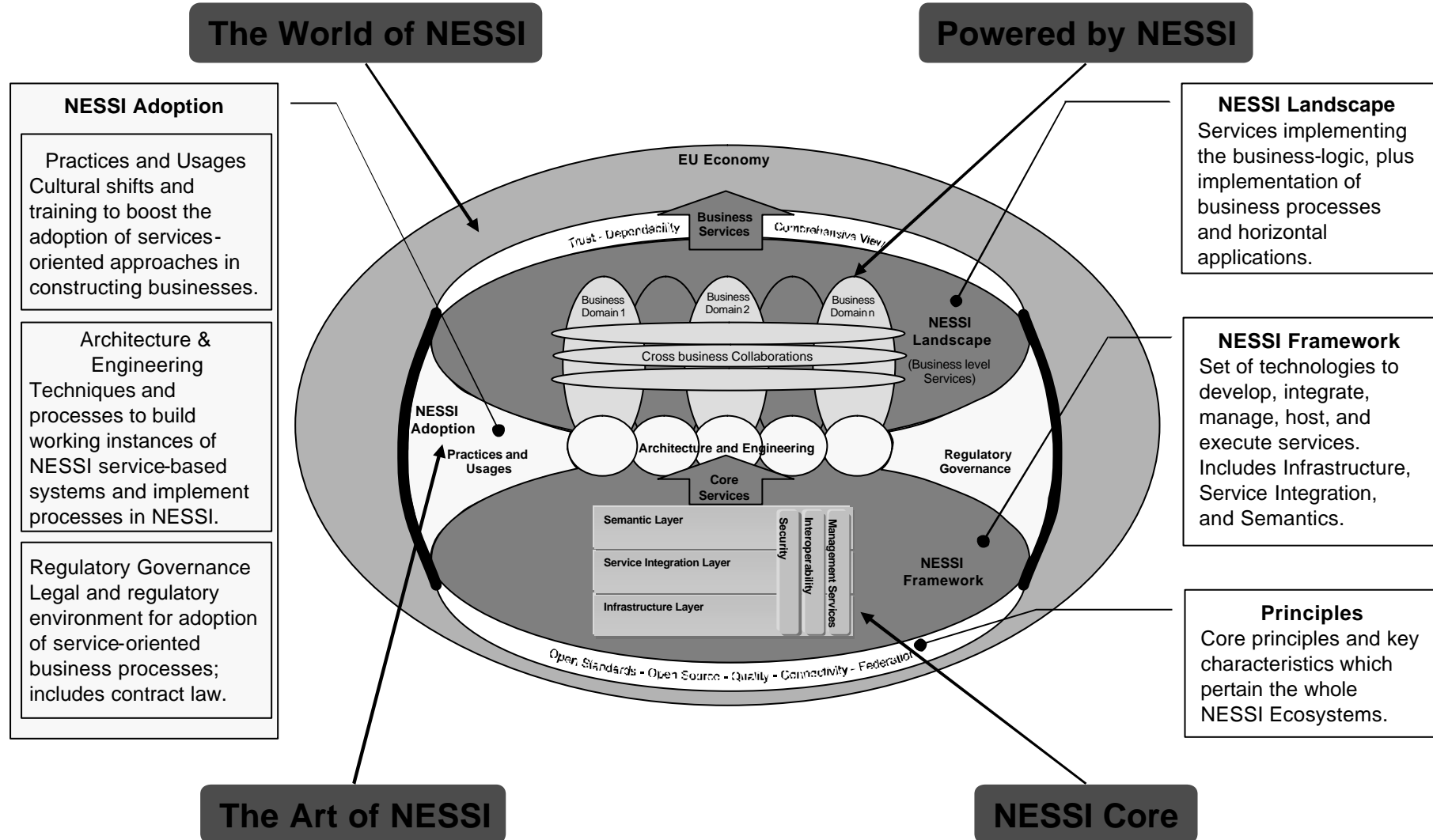


The NESSI initiative aims to provide a **common basis** for European research in **Services and Software** and their provision as a service oriented **utility** in order to establish the technological basis and the strategies that will **speed up services ecosystem dynamics**, by

- providing European industry (notably SMEs) and public sector with technology to master complex software systems for innovation and growth;
- transforming Software and Services Industry in Europe to achieve a leadership position;
- fostering the well-being of citizens through new societal applications, enhanced efficiency of industry and public sector, and competitive labour market;

in this way driving the transformation of the European economy toward a knowledge based economy based on service-oriented business models.

NESSI Holistic View



NESSI is about transforming the EU economy through Service Oriented business models



■ Reaching the Vision is THE Challenge:

reaching the vision through a balanced construction of **all** the elements of the holistic view, which is far more than completing a single research agenda, however comprehensive.

■ Driving the Paradigm Shift:

achieving an effective transformation of the business models of the EU Economy from a product perspective to effective knowledge-based and service-oriented business paradigms.

■ Dealing with Complexity:

keeping service-based systems under control and efficient, avoiding to be under-performing or limited by a “wall of complexity”.

■ The Tension of Trust:

building, along with the whole model, the holistic view of trust, security and dependability, with significant advances over the current level of service while balancing expectations which are often contradictory.

■ Keeping it OPEN:

constructing a world offering a level playing field for all actors, and where win-win relationships far outnumber win-loose relationships.

■ Transforming Vision into Reality and Building Active Support:

making it happen – avoiding to be on the wrong side of “*vision without implementation is hallucination*” (attributed to Thomas Edison).

■ **Short-term:**

bootstrap an active community around NESSI and provide a reference architecture, a series of interoperable reference implementations, and testbeds which are a required foundation for NESSI-related research, development, and experimentation. Import knowledge and technologies in NESSI.

■ **Mid-term:**

complete the portfolio, address the issues associated with the wide-scale, multi-cultural, or service-orientated deployment of existing areas, such as technologies, policies, knowledge,... Apply a multi-disciplinary approach to research.

■ **Long-term:**

go beyond the boundaries set by existing paradigms, establish new fields of science, build and test theories to fuel future NESSI-related research.

■ **Coordination:**

NESSI does not specify the complete set of topics required to reach the holistic vision; it does however work with other communities and initiatives through integrated cross-research frameworks to drive alignment. This includes both an inbound synchronization, such as gathering requirements, and an outbound synchronization, such as enticing others to build on NESSI – “Powered by NESSI”.
